AUSTRALIA UNITES RALLY Midday Saturday 13 September – Hyde Park, Sydney with March through the CBD

The *Australia Unites* rally will proceed in Sydney this Saturday, gathering at Hyde Park at midday before marching through the CBD and returning to the park.

The event calls attention to the reality that Australians are

- sicker than ever before,
- poorer than ever before,
- more stressed and depressed,
- with more people without homes,
- paying more tax,
- living under greater government control, and
- facing a threat of foreign organisations reaching into their daily lives.

For years, Australians have been using their right to free speech to call for change. Instead of listening, government leaders and the media have gaslit, labelled and dismissed them.

“Charlie Kirk, an American commentator who used his platform to speak out and call for change, was tragically assassinated this week as anger and hostility replaced open minds and respectful discourse. That is what happens when leadership fails to foster dialogue and support positive change.

Do not let Australia follow this example. Our rally is designed to highlight everyday Australian concerns and to extend an invitation to government to respond — not to label us, dismiss us, or divide us. Because when leaders choose dismissal and division, they risk fuelling the very hatred and violence we all want to avoid. Our rally is an SOS for people who are hurting and who feel silenced — a chance to stand together, work together, and create the changes we’re looking for — together with government if they’ll listen,” said organiser Mary-Jane Liddicoat.

Featured Speakers

Keynote speakers are **Professor Gigi Foster** — economist at UNSW and co-founder of the *Council for Science and Freedom*, one of Australia’s leading voices for academic freedom, integrity in public policy, and community wellbeing — and former Qantas **Captain Graham “Hoody” Hood**, who resigned from his distinguished aviation career to speak the truth

openly and without compromise, becoming a trusted voice of courage and honesty for thousands of Australians.

As with past Millions March events—including some of the largest demonstrations in Sydney (2021) and Canberra (2022)—organisers emphasise the rally will be peaceful, family-friendly, and police-approved.

We are everyday Australians standing for accountability, fairness, and the needs of our communities.
